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Old Business:

Review of the agenda for the Unit Meeting Rachel to make a PowerPoint with the agenda items for each speaker

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Treasurer's Report: \$19,274.62 see details in Unit meeting report

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New Business:

Risk Management is still a major issue regarding the timeliness of notifying our Unit when a referee becomes eligible for games; the process has been discussed by all of the DRAs at the State level with no changes acknowledged. Many units have similar difficulties and this results in some referees becoming ineligible for being assigned games. Part of the difficulty is that some referees register rather late within this process since it takes a few weeks before being cleared by the Risk Management person and actually notifying our Unit representative (e.g. Rachel).

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A resolution must be created at the State level. Therefore, it was strongly suggested that Dan appear at the next State Referee Committee (SRC) and enter into the discussion with all of the DRAs and the State Executive members. Bill will notify when this SRC meeting occurs and Dan is willing to attend to have direct discussion to resolve this even with results/changes possible for the next season.

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Another resolution is to start the entire new entry level referee courses earlier in the year (e.g. January) and complete this by March in order to allow for an earlier notification of referees to be eligible (i.e. clearance from Risk Management). This was agreed to implement for next season.

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This topic will be continued with an update in Old Business at the next meeting; topic tabled

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No Show Referee procedure (NSR) and document: The present process is that an assignor notifies Bill who notifies the Unit Treasurer who creates the letter stating the appropriate fine that is assessed. This season our Unit needs to acquire a referee (e.g. No Show Administrator as listed on our website) who would be willing to be the 'Field Marshall' who is part of the NSR Committee. Dan will

advertise for that opportunity at our next Unit meeting.

<u>Bankcard signatures</u>: Steve Wu is automatically designated to be eligible to use our Unit card since he is the State Treasurer. Shane's name will also be eligible for authorization use.

Room Use/Location of Unit meetings: The Harlem Road Community Center, 4255 Harlem Road, Amherst, NY 14226 Phone: 631-7200 was recommended. Website information: The Harlem Road Community Center provides space for meetings, presentations, programs and classes. Access to the facility allows community groups, small businesses and private individuals to present programs that enrich the quality of life in our community.

This discussion included the need for referees to actually attend any Unit meeting and how to encourage more referees to attend. This topic will be added to Old Business for our next BWNYSRU Board meeting. Topic tabled.

Additional ArbiterSports names: Presently our paid limit (e.g. 600) has been reached and new members need to be added as they have completed all of the eligibility requirements. Motion by Steph and seconded by Rachel to add payment for an additional 25 referees as anticipated new limit from the new class of graduates as stipulated by Bill. Unanimous vote to accept the motion.

 Access to ArbiterSports computer program: Steph, Coordinator of the Mentor Program, needs direct access to acquire specific information about each mentor. A list of position titles and actual names of Unit members who have access to specific areas within ArbiterSports was acquired. To have access as an assignor it requires a prerequisite course to be completed. Bill will request that Steph be added to the official list of referees allowed to have special privileges to access ArbiterSports in the ways that allows her to coordinate her information for all mentors. A new title may need to be added to this list as some present referees will be eliminated as their duties have changed. Bill will report back to the Board.

<u>Job Descriptions</u>: Acquiring this will be tabled for our next Board meeting; topic tabled.
